## **Instructions**

Online course on the International Accountability Mechanisms for Myanmar

## **General information**

The course is available in Burmese and English at: https://elearning.asia-ajar.org

Anyone is free to take the course. There is no requirement to register or enroll. For security reasons, you do not have to write your name or email address.

Feel free to share the course with your network. Anyone is welcome to use it, at any time, with as many people as you want. You may take the course individually, on your own, or you may do it together with a group (for example with your organization/team).

The course contains 8 modules:

- Module 1: Introduction (Transitional justice, Prosecutions)
- Module 2: International Independent Fact-Finding Mission on Myanmar (FFM)
- Module 3: Independent Investigative Mechanism for Myanmar (IIMM)
- Module 4: International Criminal Court (ICC) Part 1 Options for jurisdiction
- Module 5: International Criminal Court (ICC) Part 2 The current investigation
- Module 6: International Court of Justice (ICJ)
- Module 7: Universal Jurisdiction & the Argentina case
- Module 8: Conclusion (Transitional justice, Civil society strategies)

Each module contains a training video, a written handout and quiz questions, to facilitate self-learning by participants. We recommend that you start with module 1: watch the video, then review the handout(s), and finally do the quiz. Move to module 2 when you are done, then module 3, 4 etc.

You will find the answers to all the quiz questions at the end of the course, after the last module.

## **Step by step instructions**

Go to AJAR e-learning website by clicking on: <a href="https://elearning.asia-ajar.org">https://elearning.asia-ajar.org</a>. Find the course that says "International Accountability Mechanisms for Myanmar" (English) or (Burmese), and click on "Get started".






You can see all the 8 modules. From here, you can decide to click on whatever module you want to do. We recommend that you start with module 1, and do all the modules in order from 1 to 8.



Click on the module that you want to do. For example, "Module one: Introduction".

On your screen, you can see the picture of a video, with the teacher. Under the picture, in "Lesson content", you can see "Module 1 Handouts" and "Module 1 quiz". You will go to the handout and quiz <u>after</u> you watch the video.



We recommend that, for each module, you **start by watching the video**. Click on the arrow button to start the video.

You can enlarge the video in full-screen by clicking on the little box at the bottom right of the screen.



After you watch the video, click on "Exit full screen" at the bottom right of the video.

Scroll to go under the video, and click on "Module 1 Handouts".



Here you can see all the written documents that are at your disposal for learning more about the topic.

## Module 1 Handouts



Click on "Module 1 Handout (1/4): HR and TJ – Burmese". It opens the document in the full window. You can read it here online and/or you can download it in your computer or print it. (Be careful of security issues if you download it or print it.)

After your read the document, you have to click on the back arrow to return to the previous page. Depending on your computer and software it might look different. The back arrow might be at the top right or top left corner of your screen. (If you do not find it, you can simply come back to the main course by clicking here: <a href="https://elearning.asia-ajar.org/courses/international-justice-and-accountability-mechanisms-for-myanmar-burmese/">https://elearning.asia-ajar.org/courses/international-justice-and-accountability-mechanisms-for-myanmar-burmese/</a>, and then navigate your way back to where you were.)

Now that you are back on the page of Module 1, you can click on "Module 1 Quiz".





#### Module 1 Quiz


